

- •Total nonfarm employment in the Asheville Metro area experienced a loss of 6,300 jobs, or 3%, in October when compared to the same point a year ago.
- •71% of October employment loss year-over-year was attributed to Leisure & Hospitality with a pull-back of 4,500 jobs compared to October of 2023.
- •The Information and Financial Activity sectors remained stable while Construction and the Health Services & Private Education sectors collectively added 1,000 new jobs.
- •The Government sector which includes local, state, and federal employment in the Asheville Metro, as well as public education, experienced an estimated loss of 1,300 jobs.
- •The Asheville Metro continued to outpace state and national hourly average wage growth with an 8% increase October year-over-year.
- •Residential home sales experienced a 30% decline October year-over-year.
