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December 2024 Summary in the wake of Hurricane Helene

- +The Asheville Metro unemployment rate continued to decline following the initial spike from Hurricane Helene. The December preliminary unemployment rate in the Asheville Metro is 5.1%.
- +Total nonfarm employment in the Asheville Metro area experienced a loss of 2,000 jobs (-1%) in December when compared to the same point a year ago.
- +65% of December employment loss year-over-year was attributed to Leisure & Hospitality with a decline of 1,300 jobs compared to December of 2023.
- +The Information and Financial Activity sectors remained stable while Construction and the Health Services & Private Education sectors collectively added 2,000 new jobs.
- +The Government sector which includes local, state, and federal employment in the Asheville Metro, as well as public education, experienced an estimated loss of 1,500 jobs.
- +The Asheville Metro continued to outpace state and national hourly average wage growth with an 8.4% increase December year-over-year.
- +Residential home sales experienced a 1.2% decline December year-over-year.
- +Airport passenger activity saw a year-over-year decline of 16.2% in December. This is a robust improvement compared to October and November 2024.
